**WASTE MANAGEMENT CONTRACT**– Supt. Kudrick reviewed the contract with Waste Management because it is a three year contract and we are only in the first year of it. This could pose a problem if the staff of the wastewater plant start hauling waste to Merrimack. Chairman Baines asked if they could be on an on call basis. Supt. Kudrick will contact Waste Management to see what can be done about the contract.

**MERRIMACK DUMPING CONTRACT** – Supt. Kudrick gave the Commissioners the contract with the Merrimack Solid Waste Facility for their review.

**TRUCK SPECIFICATIONS** – Supt. Kudrick told the Commissioners that he is about ready to send out specifications for the new wastewater hauling truck to bid.

**ROUTE 3 REROUTING OF SEWER** – Supt. Kudrick told the Board that Ernie Jeffery from NHDOT called to inform him that sewer pipe can be laid under the culvert along Benton Road. However, the new line would need to start from the pump station, which is over 1100 feet of new line, at least doubling the cost of the original proposal.
