

**Hooksett Sewer Commission**  
**January 3, 2012**  
**Minutes**

The meeting was called to order at 12:00 PM. Present were Chairman Sidney Baines, Commissioner Roger Bergeron, Superintendent Bruce Kudrick and Bethany Hague. Commissioner Frank Kotowski was excused. Also in attendance was Todd Lizotte from the Hooksett Town Council.

**APPROVE & SIGN MINUTES FROM DECEMBER 20, 2011**

Commissioner Bergeron made a motion to accept the December 20, 2011 as read. Chairman Baines seconded. All in favor, motion carried unanimously.

**READ CORRESPONDENCE**

**FINANCIAL REPORT** – There was no financial report.

**SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT**

**YEARLY FLOWS** - Supt. Kudrick submitted his flows report to the Commissioners. Flows from 2011 were slightly higher than 2010, but nowhere near the levels of 2009. Chairman Baines asked percentage of capacity is being used and was informed it was 80%.

**K-MART PUMP STATION** – Supt. Kudrick told the Board that the flow for the K-Mart pump station has doubled in the past two weeks. Even on Christmas day, when nothing in the area was open, the station was still running. He believes that the state might have cracked a pipe while they were blasting along Route 3, as it seems to be only clean water running through the pipes. He will get a TV crew to come and look at the line.

**BOILER** – The boiler broke down again, and did not work from last Thursday afternoon to Friday night about 7pm. The technician is not sure if what he did will actually solve the problem for the long term. The boiler manufacturer is being contacted, and both Penta and Graves Engineering have been made aware of the problem.

**BUDGET** – The final budget is \$16.19 less than last year. Supt. Kudrick informed the Board about the lack of communication from the Town as to when he will be presenting his budget. The town did not include him on the emails notifying town departments of budget meetings, and hasn't for the last two years. No one at Town Hall seems to know why this has happened.
