

Hooksett Sewer Commission
May 6, 2013
Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 12:00 PM. Present were Chairman Sidney Baines, Commissioner Roger Bergeron, Superintendent Bruce Kudrick and Bethany Hague. Commissioner Frank Kotowski was excused.

APPROVE & SIGN MINUTES FROM APRIL 15, 2013

Commissioner Bergeron made a motion to accept the April 15, 2013 minutes as read. Chairman Baines seconded. All in favor, motion carried unanimously.

READ CORRESPONDENCE

FINANCIAL REPORT – There was no financial report.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

KRUGER – Representatives from Kruger and Penta will be coming on May 7th to clean the air sparges in tanks 3 and 4. Ken Kessler from DES knows that they are coming. Supt. Kudrick also informed the Board that Underwood Engineers was awarded the contract by DES to review all of the Kruger modifications.

CLARIFIER #1– Supt. Kudrick informed the Board that the center column in clarifier #1 has rusted out and he has been trying to contact the company to see what needs to be done to fix it. Most likely a crane will be needed to install the new column.

TRACTOR– The Massey Ferguson tractor is no longer needed due to the new John Deere and Supt. Kudrick would like to sell it. He will contact other town departments to see if they are interested in it before he tries to sell it elsewhere. The state is no longer holding auctions in Concord for surplus supplies, things need to be brought to a facility in Epping and he is not sure if there are fees involved.

DEDUCT METERS – Supt. Kudrick gave the Board information regarding the costs the sewer customers will incur when the Central and Village Water Precincts will no longer read the deduct meters. EJ Prescott and Stiles Company have submitted quotes that include the costs for new meter heads and for the companies to read the meters once a year. The cost of reading the meters would be passed on to only sewer customers with deduct meters. The final amount for that once a year reading would not be calculated until the number of those interested homeowners is known.
