

Hooksett Sewer Commission
June 3, 2013
Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 11:45 PM. Present were Commissioner Frank Kotowski, Commissioner Roger Bergeron, Superintendent Bruce Kudrick and Bethany Hague. Chairman Sidney Baines was excused.

APPROVE & SIGN MINUTES FROM MAY 20, 2013

Commissioner Bergeron made a motion to accept the May 20, 2013 minutes as read. Commissioner Kotowski seconded. All in favor, motion carried unanimously.

READ CORRESPONDENCE

FINANCIAL REPORT – There was no financial report.

SUPERINTENDENT’S REPORT

FLOWS-The flows were down for the month of May due to decreased rainfall for the month and the continuing work on stopping infiltration into the system.

SOUTHERN NH PLANNING – At a recent meeting at Southern NH Planning, it was found that the state is basing its numbers regarding phosphorus and other matter on the permitted discharge of the treatment plants, not what is actually being used. Those numbers are skewing the results of testing and treatment plans. The operators concerns will be brought to the state.

MIXER- The plant has lost another mixer in the B&R tank. A new mixer will be \$4000, so Supt. Kudrick will try to find someone to fix the old one for less money.

CLARIFIER- The cost of the replacing the center post in the clarifier have been submitted to Supt. Kudrick. The post will cost \$4923, the gasket \$412, a new bearing will be \$8466 and the work itself will cost \$16,500. Although the bearing is not quite ready to be replaced, to do so requires removing the catwalk which will be done for the clarifier fix. It makes more sense to replace it now in terms of costs. Commissioner Kotowski made a motion to expend the monies to replace the center column of the clarifier, Commissioner Bergeron seconded. All in favor, motion carried unanimously.

GATE FOR GOLDEN GATE- The gate and fence at the pump station needs to be replaced. Currently the estimate for the work is \$4100, but Supt. Kudrick will be looking for other quotes.

BOD VIOLATIONS – There were two violations in May. However, they happened during the week that Kruger was here running tests, and tanks 3 & 4 were shut down. Tanks 1 & 2 didn’t

have enough bacteria in them to regulate the BODs as much. The numbers have come down since.

LEO LAVIN – Mr. Lavin has passed his CDL licensing and has now completed all requirements for his first year of employment.
