READ CORRESPONDENCE

FINANCIAL REPORT – There was no financial report.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

LILAC BRIDGE – Supt. Kudrick informed the Board that he had contacted the EPA regarding the problems of the Lilac Bridge and what is the proposed remedy by the state and town. Basically he was told that as long as nothing is accidentally dumped into the river by the sewer pipe during the restoration process the Sewer Department/Town should be fine.

SCHOOL TOURS – Some of the classes at the elementary school will be coming for a tour of the plant in the next few weeks.

CLARIFIER – Tank 1 had to be pumped out for repairs. Supt. Kudrick is using this time to have it repainted as it has not be done in over 20 years.

RT 3 - There is an old sewer line located in front of PSNH on Rt. 3 that was being grouted (plugged) because it was no longer in service. The company responsible for performing the grouting pumped in over 7 ½ yards of concrete and it did not fill the pipe. No one seems to know why that happened as there was more than enough concrete to do the job, so they have to come back and address the problem.
