Financial Report: Guy came in to give the Sewer Commission a brief overview of the sewer commission accounts. Commissioner Frank Kotowski made motion to transfer \$3,900.00 from the Hooksett Sewer Commission checking account to the Hooksett Sewer Commission property enhancement trust account for the third quarter fiscal year 2021 rent collected. Commissioner Richard Bairam seconded. All in favor, the motion was carried unanimously. Guy informed the commission that all encumbrance's need to be in for the next meeting.

Superintendent Conaty's Report:

Plant:

 The new fire and security alarm was installed in the Sewer Commission office. The fire department will be down on May 25th to do their inspection.

Shincci Dryer:

- HVAC Professional was brought in to look at the dryer. 75-80% of the Freon was missing.
- RMI has been staffing the dryer for the last 4 weeks
- The Hooksett Sewer Commission sent the letter to RMI ending the pilot with the dryer on 5/31/21. Today marks 9 more working days with the dryer.
- Superintendent Conaty is researching other vendors for sludge disposal options i.e.: Huber
 & Gryphon
- The Plant is to resume hauling sludge to Merrimack on 06/01/2021

TIF Project:

Next TIF meeting is scheduled for Thursday @3pm. In the Town Hall gymnasium

Force Main Replacement:

 Superintendent Conaty met with Ron Corriveau and Dave Mercier about the location and path for the force main replacement.

Dewatering upgrade/pilot study:

Last summer were:

- Andritz Centrifuge –German
- FKC Screw Press Japanese
- Huber Screw Press –German
- Ishigaki Screw Press Japanese/USA Maine combination
- PW Tech Moving Volute Press –USA Washington

This year are:

- Centrisys Centrifuge –USA Wisconsin June 7th
- Westfalia Centrifuge –German June 14th
- BDP Screw Press –USA New York

Other:

- The solar project is complete. The security deposit that the Sewer Commission is holding can now be released for payment.
- The Sewer Commission is applying for \$130 million worth of Federal Funding to put toward the Force Main and dewatering projects.
- The sewer commission is going to reallocate the 1.2 million offered to the TIF, due to lack of interest in the project, to work on the force main and martin's ferry pump station. This will help the overall project not lose any more momentum. The sewer commission has made its contribution to crossing the river near exit 11. As far as exit 10 is concerned the sewer commission is in the process of upgrading the plant for another 5 million to help with that part of the project. The sewer commission also wants to develop the pipeline from Martin's Ferry to the plant which will cost an additional 2 million. The sewer commission has applied for federal funds to help with cost. The sewer commission feels that if these projects get completed the plant will be ready for whatever the TIF decides to do on the other side of the river.
