Financial Report: Guy Beloin came in to give a brief overview of the Hooksett Sewer Commission accounts. Commissioner Richard Bairam made motion to transfer \$26,340.00 from the Hooksett Sewer Commission Trust property enhancements account to the Hooksett Sewer Commission checking account for relocating fence line. Commissioner Robert Duhaime seconded. All in favor, the motion was carried unanimously.

Superintendent Conaty's Report:

Plant:

- Plant still running excellent discharge numbers with 1 chlorine violation on July 5, 2022. The violation was reported to NHDES and EPA.
- Still waiting on results for DMR QA study
- The BNR tanks are being demolished and repurposed
- They are dealing with an issue with RAS/WAS line down at the plant. There seems to be a restriction.
- Superintendent Conaty is currently working on the 2023-2024 budget. Superintendent Ken
 Conaty let the Sewer Commission know that the chemical, fuel and electricity budget lines are
 not pretty, cost have significantly gone up.

Solar:

 The fence relocation is on hold for now. PBR needs to move material that is in the way of completing the fence.

- Solar is above production, Assistant Superintendent John Clark reviewed the solar sheet with the Sewer Commission (attachment 1).
- The mower that was ordered to mow around the solar array is believed to have made it onto the boat in Sweden.

TIF Project:

- Underwood has the design complete and has submitted it to NHDES
- Superintendent Conaty was assisting with the Tri Town easement. It is completed and has been sent to the attorney for proofing.
- Superintendent Conaty is working with Underwood on the final design details of the pump station
- TIF meeting tomorrow July 20th @ 4pm.
