Financial Report: Guy came in to give a brief overview of the Hooksett Sewer Commission accounts.

 Commissioner Richard Bairam made motion to transfer \$441,107.44 from the Hooksett Sewer Commission Trust plant & composting account to the Hooksett Sewer Commission checking account for reimbursing PBR & Underwood for phase 3A Capital Improvements. Commissioner Robert Duhaime seconded. All in favor, the motion was carried unanimously.

 probe in the amount of \$6402.00 plus additional cost for shipping, installation ect.
