# Hooksett Sewer Commission June 18, 2024 Meeting Minutes

INITIAL B COMMENTS

## **Approve and Sign Manifest**

**Approve meeting minutes:** Commissioner Richard Bairam made motion to approve the regular and workshop minutes from June 4, 2024. Chairman Sidney Baines seconded. All in favor, the motion was carried unanimously.

## Read Correspondence

**Financial Report:** Guy came in to give the Sewer Commission a brief overview of the Sewer Commission accounts.

- Commissioner Richard Bairam made motion to transfer \$45,418.84 from the HSC trust- capital plants and composting account to the HSC checking account to reimburse attached expenditures. Chairman Sidney Baines seconded. All in favor, the motion was carried unanimously.
- Commissioner Richard Bairam made motion to correct the approved transfer from April 16, 2024 to say "Transfer \$82,000 from the HSC trust-plant and composting account instead of from the HSC trust- capital reserve account." Chairman Sidney Baines seconded. All in favor, the motion was carried unanimously.
- Commissioner Richard Bairam made motion to transfer \$41,700 from the HSC checking account to the HSC trust- capital reserve account from the proceeds of the sale of the 1996 Peterbuilt Truck. Chairman Sidney Baines seconded. All in favor, the motion was carried unanimously.

#### Plant:

- Plant numbers are good right now. TSS 17.1mg/l and BOD 11.1mg/l
- pH was riding around 7.00
- EPA permit listening group. The permits are open for public comment, Superintendent Conaty is still waiting.
- Rick Cantu came in to go over the schedule (8 weeks of sampling)
- PAC was shut off to see the effects it would have. Aluminum levels dropped considerably, 23mg/l to 5mg/l
